RE: Public Records Request — Data Center Incentive certification and Fee-in-Lieu approval for xAI / MZX Tech, LLC (“Project Synergy,” Southaven / DeSoto County)

To the Public Records Officer:

Pursuant to the Mississippi Public Records Act (Miss. Code Ann. § 25-61-1 et seq.), I request access to and copies of the following records for the period June 1, 2025 to present, pertaining to xAI, MZX Tech, LLC, or any affiliate, and the project referred to as “Project Synergy” or “MACROHARDRR” in Southaven and DeSoto County:

1. The complete application for certification as a data center enterprise under Miss. Code Ann. § 57-113-21 et seq., including all representations regarding capital investment, number of jobs to be created, and wage levels;
2. The certificate or agreement issued by MDA granting the sales and use tax exemption, and all conditions attached to it;
3. All records showing the minimum job-creation and wage thresholds MDA applied to this certification, and any waiver, modification, or interpretation of those thresholds;
4. All compliance reports, annual reports, job-count verifications, or clawback analyses submitted by or concerning the company;
5. The Certificate of Final Approval of the Fee-in-Lieu Agreement executed by the Executive Director on or about February 24, 2026, together with the complete application and supporting materials submitted for that approval under Miss. Code Ann. § 27-31-104(3);
6. All correspondence between MDA and the company, its consultants, its counsel, the City of Southaven, or DeSoto County concerning the certification, the exemption, or the Fee-in-Lieu Agreement;
7. Any economic-impact analysis, cost-benefit analysis, or fiscal note MDA prepared or received concerning the project.

If MDA takes the position that any responsive record is confidential commercial or financial information, please identify the record, the claimant, and the statutory basis, and produce all reasonably segregable portions.

If any portion of this request is withheld or redacted, please identify each record withheld and cite the specific statutory exemption relied upon, as required by the Mississippi Public Records Act. If any records do not exist, please confirm that in writing. Electronic delivery (email or download link) is preferred. If estimated fees will exceed \$25, please contact me with an estimate before fulfillment.

Please note that Miss. Code Ann. § 25-61-5 requires a response within seven (7) working days of receipt.
